Results:

We take pride in mentioning that consistency in result has become the hallmark of the college. The results of 2015-16 have been very encouraging. The average pass percentage of UG courses is 92.62% with BBA and BCA leading with 100% followed by B.Com with 98.54%, B.Sc(Life Sciences) with 90.83%, B.A with 89.47% and B.Sc(Physical Sciences) with 81.51%. The average pass percentage for postgraduate courses is 94.63% where MBA leads with 99.09% followed by M.Com with 96.30%, M.Sc(Microbiology) with 88.89%, M.Sc(Biochemistry) with 85.71% and M.Sc(Comp. Sc) with 85% .
